International Trap

(Not for the faint of heart)

We have ramped up our wobble trap to simulate the game of International Trap (also called Olympic or Bunker trap). Not familiar? Regular trap throws birds around 42 mph (about 50 yards) anywhere in a 34 degree angle, at a fixed height. International trap throws birds around 62 mph (about 83 yards) anywhere in a 90 degree angle, at varying heights.

There are 33 International trap fields in the US, none in Michigan. International trap has 15 machines, but our 1 machine simulates the speed and all the angles you'll get with International trap.

We will offer this challenging game starting now (except during the ATA shoot). How long it will be available is up to you. If we get enough interest it will stay for a while. Through the month of October, if you shoot a 23 or better we will reimburse you for the cost of your line.

Come out and try it while it's available. Crying towels provided.

The last shotgun plate shoot of the will be on Saturday October 13th starting at 10:00 am. As usual, we will be having two events for this. The main event which consists of twelve targets, and the El Presidente, which has a total of six targets. Only #8 and #9 shot is allowed due to the short distance to the targets, and for safety. Two boxes should suffice if you only shoot the main event, but three boxes will do if you shoot both events. At only five dollars per event it would be silly not to shoot both. You will go through each event three times and we will document your times for each run through. This is not a competition where you shoot against other people. You will only compete against yourself. Because of this, any shotgun style or gauge is welcome. You need not be a club member to participate. So bring a buddy or two and have a ball shooting steel plates. As usual, this event is weather dependent. If it's raining or threat of rain, the shoot will be canceled. We normally wrap it up around 2:00 so plan accordingly. We hope to see you there. If you have any questions please feel free to contact me at pl8shootr@sbcglobal.net.
