
Calling all Jakes

Larry Clark was the first one of the season at West Walker to shoot a forty in the Big Bore production category right off the get go and then turn around and shoot another one in Small Bore! What a way to get us all motivated and pumped up for the season. Way to go Larry.

What was really impressive though, was the scores shot in field pistol category by Ron Springsteen and Gary Peake using .32 and 45 ACP auto's with iron sights. Ron shot a 26 while Gary shot a 25. There were six entries in Field Pistol shooting 9mm, .32, .40, and .45 semi-autos. All you semi-auto shooters that shoot the close range plate matches ought to try using them in this game, where you have forty steel silhouette targets set at 25, 50, 75, and 100 yards. If you think a 9 or 45 at 100 yards is not accurate, then come on out and see it done. Better yet why not try it for yourself.

Remember, our matches are the third Saturday of each month beginning at 10 a.m.. Sanctioned IHMSA categories are shot these

days also. We usually have food and pop available and there is always a friendly member to help spot targets for you, explain the course of fire and willing to share their knowledge of the sport.
