# When using West Walker's shooting ranges, please check in at the

### Range monitor building before shooting.

In or around the Monitor building you will find a range monitor. A range monitor will be on site during normal club shooting hours. The range monitor will ask to see your membership card (if you need to buy a membership or renew a membership, they can do it right there). They will also make sure you have ear and eye protection, which is required. They will also monitor and enforce the club rules. **Any charter member can also ask you to verify your membership and to obey the club rules**.

## Rifle Range Improvements.

Work continues on the Associate rifle ranges. The windows on the ranges have recently been adjusted. Some shooters were having some difficulty with the new safety structure which has been added to the rifle range. It seems people using a Lead Sled Rest could not get their rest to work with the new structure. The openings have been reexamined and adjusted. Some associates who use the Lead Sled report the adjustments seem to have solved the problem. Please remember, all the improvements and changes being made to the ranges are being done to promote safety. Which should be everyone's number one concern? 

# **Rifle Ranges**

The Club has begun more improvements on the rifle ranges. The new structure being added to the front of the shooting stations is modeled after similar structures used by the State of Michigan at their rifle ranges. We will also be instituting some new rules & regulations for use of the ranges. We will be publishing them in the near future. The range monitor program is starting to take shape and we have received many positive comments from the associates. It appears most members think it is a great benefit to have someone in charge of the ranges. Concerning range use: The rifle ranges at West Walker are designed for target shooting and sighting in of rifles only and all shooting must be done from the benches. Paper targets on the target boards are the only targets allowed. There is no

shooting allowed from prone, kneeling or standing positions. If you need to practice from a prone, kneeling or standing position, it must be done somewhere else. It cannot be done at the West Walker ranges!
