#### UPCOMING RIFLE RANGE SAFETY CHANGES

Changes almost seem to be happening daily on the 50-200 yard rifle range. One of the next changes to be implemented over the next couple of weeks will be a range safety flag system. This will be a **RED FLAG** hung on the firing line. When anyone goes down range for any reason they will have to remove the flag from the firing line and place it in the holder at the first wall down range. Anyone else going down range must make themselves known to the person who put the flag out. When you see the Red Flag on the wall, the range is COLD and **NO SHOOTING** is allowed!! The person who put the flag out will be the only one who can take it down and return it to the firing line. So Please be sure everyone is back from being down range. Make sure you check with the range monitor for more information.
