ANOTHER SHOTGUN FUN SHOOT Saturday October 10th

Saturday, October 10th, we will have the last shotgun plate shoot of the season on the charter range. We have steel plates that swing, plates that fall over, and bowling pins to blow out of their stands.

Any gauge and type of action is welcome. Since the targets are only 36 feet from the shooter, and for safety reasons, only No. 8 or 9 shot is allowed. The main event will have twelve targets, which will consist of a combination of steel plates and bowling pins. The side event will consist of six clay pigeons. So come on out and smack some targets with lead.

Starting time will be 10:00 am. Cost is \$5.00 for the main event and \$5.00 for the side event. This lets you shoot both stages all day. Get there at 10 AM so we can go through the safety rules and course description. **You do not need to be a club member to participate**. So bring your buddies out and see who has the best run.

DEER RIFLE SIGHT IN

All of you Deer hunters out there might want to get your sighting in early this year. Don't wait until the last minute to come out to the range in November to sight that Deer rifle in. You may be in for a surprise if you haven't been out to the range since last deer season. A lot of changes have taken place. Because of the safety changes made to the range it may take you a little longer to sight in. So come on out early and avoid the last minute rush and possible delays.

RIFLE RANGE SAFETY CHANGE IN EFFECT

The Rifle Range safety flag system is in effect on a trial basis to see how it works out. This will be a **RED FLAG** hung on the firing line. When anyone goes down range for any reason they will have to remove the flag from the firing line and place it in the holder at the first wall down range. Anyone else going down range must make themselves known to the person who put the flag out. When you see the Red Flag on the wall, the range is COLD and **NO SHOOTING** is allowed!! The person who put the flag out will be the only one who can take it down and return it to the firing line. So Please be sure everyone is back from being down range. Make sure you check with the range monitor for more information.
