The DNR will only be checking deer during the regular Rifle Deer season, **November 15-25 and November 30**. Hours of operation are expected to be 9am-3pm each day. During all other deer seasons, deer can be checked at the DNR Operations Service Centers. In Kent County, where deer checking is mandatory due to CWD, there will be several locations open for deer checking throughout the entire deer season.
