Dear West Walker Membership,

Greetings from Kandahar, Afghanistan! I am assigned to the Brigade Support Medical Company, 25th Brigade Support Battalion, 1st of the 25th Stryker Brigade Combat Team from Fort Wainwright, Alaska.

Our Battalion Aid Station operates an amazing program, The Wolf Case Management Program (WCMP). WCMP houses and rehabilitates wounded or ill Soldiers back to health so that they are fully mission capable and can go back to the fight. The majority of these Soldiers are medically evacuated and are taken so quickly that they are not able to grab any personal belongings. Most of them show up with only the clothes on their backs.

These Heroes suffer more than just physical wounds. In a time of healing, it is extremely difficult to be away from not only your family, but your army family as well. Unfortunately, we are basically building this program from scratch and need the supplies necessary to give comfort to these Soldiers.

Due to the busy and dangerous Afghanistan summers, we are expecting an exponential increase in patients. We have contacted several programs and are expecting the packages to arrive in a short amount of time.

Unfortunately, our supplies deplete very quickly.

We are requesting supplies such as personal hygiene items, running shoes, loofa's, puzzle books, portable DVD players, DVD's, books, underwear, pajama/sweat pants, white crew cut socks, t-shirts, towels, snacks, individual powder drink mixes, handheld games, etc.

Please consider donating to our program. It's just a little price to pay for brave Heroes who protect our families and country.

Shotgun Plate Shoot October 8th 2011

The next shotgun plate shoot will be on Saturday October 8th starting at 10:00 am. As usual, we will be having two events for this. The main event which consists of twelve targets, and the El Presidente, which has a total of six targets. Only #8 and #9 shot is allowed due to the short distance to the targets, and for safety. Two boxes should suffice if you only shoot the main event, but three boxes will do if you shoot both events. At only five dollars per event it would be silly not to shoot both. You will go through each event three times and we will document your times for each run through. This is not a competition where you shoot against other people. You will only compete against yourself. Because of this, any shotgun style or gauge is welcome. You need not be a club member to participate. So bring a buddy or two and have a ball shooting steel plates. As usual, this event is weather dependent. If it's raining or threat of rain, the shoot will be canceled.
