2012 Winter Shotgun League Combination ATA League

This year our Winter shotgun league will double as a registered ATA league.

ATA members who are <u>NOT</u> WWSC members can shoot ONLY trap and/or trap doubles (ATA registered).

WWSC members can shoot <u>ALL</u> events.

The League starts Jan 4 and runs for 12 weeks, ending on April 1.

We will hold Trap, Doubles Trap and Skeet (skeet events are gauge specific, minimum of 5 shooters/event).

Trophies will be awarded for 1st and 2nd place, and High Overall (HOA must shoot both Skeet and Trap singles).

Events will be classed (not handicapped), based on 5+ shooters/class.

Registration for your 1st event is \$30.00. Registration for each additional events is \$15.00 If you are an ATA member and shooting registered targets there is an additional charge of \$15.00 per event.

Targets are \$4.50 per line. You can purchase a pre-paid card for \$54.00 (12 lines).

Doubles trap targets are \$8.00 / 50 target line, a pre-paid card for this event is \$48.00.

Each pre-paid card is a raffle ticket for a drawing for a free case of shells, winner to be drawn at the banquet.

The League Banquet will be held Saturday April 14 at 6:00pm.

Dinner and beverages are provided free of charge to <u>ALL</u> league shooters.

Guests are welcome at the banquet but there will be a small fee to cover the cost of their meal.

Trophies will be awarded at the banquet and we will hold some raffles.

Food will be available on Wed nights and Sundays. Steak Night will be the 1st Wednesday of each month (Jan 4, Feb 1, March 7),

Otherwise burgers/fries on Wed night and breakfast on Sundays.

Scores will be posted online weekly on our website (www.wwsc.org).

Practice lines for WWSC members are at member rates. Practice lines for ATA shooters who are NOT WWSC members are at the non-member rate of \$6.00 / line. Sign up anytime at the shooting desk after Dec 1st.

When using West Walker's shooting ranges please check in at the range monitor building.

In or around the Monitor building you will find a range monitor. A range monitor will be on site during normal club shooting hours. The range monitor will ask to see your membership card (if you need to buy a membership or renew a membership, they can do it right there). They will also make sure you have ear and eye protection, which is required. They will also monitor and enforce the club rules. Any charter members can also ask you to verify your membership and to obey the club rules.

Range Safety

Just a friendly reminder to our members who use the rifle and pistol ranges. Please police your area when you are finished shooting. The next shooter will thank you for not having to wade through a sea of spent brass. Please deposit your spent brass, as well as dud rounds in the white buckets hanging near each line. Do not dump duds in the trash barrels! They can pose a real hazard to our grounds committee as they mow the grass or burn trash. Things that don't burn so well, empty shotgun hulls, hard plastic, beverage containers and metal, should be put into the two big green barrels. Paper, "soft" plastic, and cardboard boxes can be put into the small metal barrels or directly into one of the burn barrels. Thanks for helping keep our ranges clean and safe for all.
