West Walker will be hosting another Air Gun match on Saturday June 16th. We are holding an air gun shoot using IHMSA targets consisting of chickens, pigs, turkeys, and rams. There will be a total of 40 targets per round. There will be two sets of targets. One for handguns and one for rifles. This is for **pellets only**, no BB's allowed. All are welcome to participate. It will be held on the charter range (the one just before the rifle range) starting at 10:00 am. The cost of a round is \$5.00. Eye protection is required but ear protection is optional. After all, we are just shooting pellet guns. Come on out to have some fun at 10:00 am on the charter range.

The next shotgun plate shoot of the year will be on Saturday June 9th starting at 10:00 am. As usual, we will be having two events for this. The main event which consists of twelve targets, and the El Presidente, which has a total of six targets. Only #8 and #9 shot is allowed due to the short distance to the targets, and for safety. Two boxes should suffice if you only shoot the main event, but three boxes will do if you shoot both events. At only five dollars per event it would be silly not to shoot both. You will go through each event three times and we will document your times for each run through. This is not a competition where you shoot against other people. You will only compete against yourself. Because of this, any shotgun style or gauge is welcome. You need not be a club member to participate. So bring a buddy or two and have a ball shooting steel plates. As usual, this event is weather dependent. If it's raining or threat of rain, the shoot will be canceled. PROPOSAL FOR: A FREE ORIENTATION TO ARCHERY CLASS

For Fund-raising and Outreach Purposes FREE Orientation to Archery Class Outline:

Eye Dominance determined

Archery safety rules

Archery equipment sized to each Archer

Basic shooting techniques - using compound bows

Grouping and consistency

The FREE Orientation to Archery **class would be appropriate for** those who have never shot a bow, or those with some previous experience that are seeking a refresher session, or re-introduction to archery using correct shooting techniques.

The first class in the Beginners Course series of 6 classes is an Orientation session and includes correctly sizing equipment to the archer (bow, arrows, safety gear etc.) and determining eye dominance (eye dominance controls aiming).

Unless you already have archery equipment that is suited for you, it is recommended that you do not purchase equipment until the student has been assessed for eye dominance, and has been shooting for a while.

We will be focusing on form and safety in the Orientation Class, giving basics that will get beginners safely shooting, and a general feel for archery.

Classes are open to all ages (9 and above) and families may shoot together.

ORIENTTON IS AN IMPORTANT CLASS AND IS REQUIRED FOR ANYONE WHO HAS NEVER SHOT BEFORE.

Orientation Class lasts about 2 hours.

Students are asked to help with equipment set up and clean up.

Parents or guardians not participating are to remain with their children (under sixteen years of age) until the lesson ends. If the parent or guardian leaves, the the child must leave also.

Waiver releases are required for all students to participate on ranges. (youth under 18: waiver to be signed by parent/guardian to participate.)

Safety rules/clothing: Before each class

- ~wear appropriate shoes tennis shoes are good
- ~wear appropriate clothes T shirts are good
- ~don't wear long dangle ear-rings or anything that would be unsafe
- ~long hair may need to be tied back

Being More Specific about Orientation Class structure:

Meet and greet beginners of any gender and any age starting with 9 to adult. Any beginners under the age of 18, without a valid driver's license must have a responsible adult present at all times, if the adult leaves for any reason, the beginner must leave also.

<u>A signed waiver is required</u> for everyone to participate (those under 18 years must have their waiver signed by parent/guardian to participate.)

The Warnings and Safety rules will personally be discussed with everyone individually when they are registering. (The Warnings and Safety rules are listed separately.)

You will be checked for eye dominance. Most every has a dominant eye which will greatly affect how you shoot. Even if you are right-handed in every other aspect of your life, if you are left eye dominant you may need to shoot a left-handed bow.

We help determine the archers strength and help them get set up with the best bow and compatible arrows, whether it's their own equipment or ours

We work on muscles, balance, combined with clear mental preparation giving a series of fundamentals that can be built upon, with practice, to become a proficient archer.

We will work on shooting together as a group in order to simulate league or championship shooting.

At the end of the Orientation class everyone will be encouraged to sign up for the Beginners Classes which will start the following week and continue for the next 5 weeks.

The beginners class costs \$60. This amount will be an entitlement to a family membership with West Walker Sportsman Club for one year~ including all full membership rights. (Those signing up for beginners classes who are already members, may participate for the next 5 weeks for free.)

THE BEGINNERS CLASS WILL WORK ON:

Review of Orientation highlights

Grouping your arrows

Scoring your points

Adjustment of your sight (using an Allen wrench or knobs)

The follow your arrow concept

Keep your eye on the X

Practice, practice, practice
