The Sportsman's Banquet

On Saturday March 24, 2018, the Sportsman's Banquet will be held at the clubhouse at O-599 Leonard St. NW. There are only 220 tickets available so purchase your tickets early to insure you have a place for this fun filled event. You do not need to be a member to attend.

No tickets will be sold at the door! Cost for the banquet is \$50 for adults and \$25 age 16 and under. This includes dinner and a door prize. Tickets ordered in groups of 8 will receive reserved seating. The fun begins at 5:30 pm with cocktails, appetizers, games and Chinese raffles. Dinner will be served at 7:00.

Details - After receipt of your check, your dinner tickets will be mailed to you.

When you arrive at the club on banquet day you will receive a packet containing your program and pre-ordered raffle packages.
