After taking the online course, (links below) you are required to attend either a home study class or the field portion of a regular class and take the student examination in order to receive your hunter safety certificate. You will need to pre-register for a home study class or the field portion of a regular class before taking this online course. Upon passing the online Pre-Certification Exam, you will be eligible to complete the skills/field portion of instruction and take a written examination without attending a classroom course.
