September 21st, 2019 Air Rifle Fun Shoot

Our air rifle fun shoot was a big success with over 80 participants showing up to shoot and register for the chance to win 2 air rifles that Al & Bob's offered to raffle off to attendee's. Most of the attendees were children with their parents. We had kids show up from American Heritage girls, GR Kids, Boy / Girl Scouts and 4H. The majority of these kids had never shot a gun before and RSO's were great with some basic instruction and impressed with their first time shooting skills!



A few seasoned shooters showed up with some really nice air rifles to shoot at all of the stations and walk through course. A special thank you needs to go out to the Grand Valley Cap and Ballers group (below left) for bringing out some youth loaner guns for the kids to shoot.



Most everyone shot the BB gun critter targets, hanging steel and chalk targets and the 5 spot paper target. There were 3 skill shot stations where shooters had to shoot at a hanging steel boar (standing position) then pop can launcher (kneeling) and finally a steel fox (prone position). The next skill shot station was shooting 3 of our new self-healing knock down bowling pin targets (they worked great) and then hitting 2 pressurized pop bottles on a motorized moving clothesline that went off with a blast! Above (right) is a picture of one of the \$30 Al & Bob's gift cert winners for shooting a perfect score hitting a special pressurized pop bottle filled with glitter! There was also a behind the back skill shot station popping water balloons while aiming through a mirror. And let's not forget the hanging steel target walk through course that saw a lot of use during the event!

Attendance was better than expected and we received a lot of compliments from shooters and parents for a great, free, family fun event! Let's hope we see some new members and more use on the walk through course from future air gunners. We will start planning events such as leagues and other fun events in the future. More to come.

Cost is \$10 per person (**members only event**)

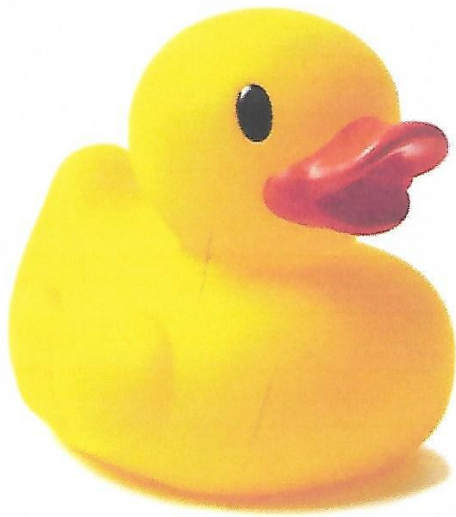
