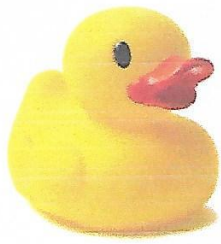

Outdoor Archery Ranges at WWSC are Open!

The Archery Committee has invested significant effort and funds in up grading the facilities at WWSC. These facilities are open for use by the Associate and Charter Members.

The bag target range adjacent to the Rifle ranges has high quality targets at distances from 10 to 60 yards in 10-yard increments. Additionally, we now have an elevated platform with a 20-yard 3D target to hone your tree stand skills. For an extra bit of fun, we have installed a 3D Buffalo target at 100 yards for anyone who wants to stretch their distance to the maximum. This range is open to associates anytime a Range Monitor is present at no cost.

The 3D Range has been improved to include better shooting stakes, new drainage and better trimming of shooting lanes. The cost is free for Charters and \$5.00 for Associates. To access the range, Associates must pay the Range Monitor and get the combination for the lock. 25 challenging 3D targets await with 3 shooting stakes setup as follows

Traditional, Yellow Stake, 10 - 20 yards

Bowhunter, Green Stake, 10 - 35 Yards

Advanced Bowhunter, Red Stake, 10 - 45 Yards
