MUZZELOADING PISTOEL SHOOTING ON MONDAY NIGHT IN THE INDOOR RANGE BUILDING



On Monday nights we are offering a special time for muzzle loading pistol shooting. This will be from four to seven in the evening. It will take place in the indoor pistol range building. If you have ever wanted to learn how to shoot a muzzle loader you should stop by. It should be noted that when it comes to shooting muzzle loaders, a different skill set is needed concerning gun safety. They also need to be cleaned soon after you shoot them, or you will have a serious rust problem. They are different than modern guns. We can help you learn these things. We have a certified instructor in pistol, rifle, and shotgun.

We have discovered that a lot of people have bought muzzle loaders but have never shot them because they were not sure how to or did not know what they needed to shoot them. It would be our pleasure to help you get started in this shooting sport. Muzzle loading can be anything from plinking, hunting or serious competition shooting. In terms of shotgun people do the same thing as a modern

shooter would when shooting trap or skeet. We can get you #11 caps and real black powder. We would need a weeks' notice to acquire these supplies. So, stop on by on Monday nights to see what it is about.
