On Saturday, May 6, 2023, WWSC hosted the first of a planned four, Hunter Education Field Days for the 2023 calendar year. There were 36 registered participants. A Hunter Education Field Day provides students with the opportunity to participate in hands-on activities that contribute to, and reinforce, the online course of study that they complete prior to the Field Day. Students had the opportunity to learn safe gun handling and tree stand safety, as well as having the opportunity to shoot shotgun, .22 rifle, muzzle loading rifle, and bow.

For many of the students, this was their first opportunity to handle and shoot a firearm or bow. Michigan Conservation Officer B.J. Goulette spent the day with us and had a great rapport with the students, helping dispel some of the confusion surrounding hunting, fishing, and trespass regulations. At the conclusion of the Field Day and, after passing a written examination, the students were issued a Michigan Hunter Safety certificate which allows them to lawfully purchase a hunting license Not only is this a great opportunity for the students, but it's also a rewarding. experience for the instructors who volunteer to teach and mentor the students. There is a huge need for additional, certified, hunter safety education instructors. both here at WWSC and statewide. The process become a certified instructor.is painless and doesn't take a lot of time. Once you've completed the testing, you. spend some time being mentored by one of our WWSC certified HSE instructors. during the next Field Day. Nothing to it! Seriously, there is an overwhelming. number of people, young and old, who are interested in learning about the sport, and you have specialized knowledge and experience that you could be passing on. to others.
