Well, we need more charters to plan and run these events.

Obligations of a Charter Applicant

- 1. Must be an associate member for six (6) months to apply for charter membership and maintain associate membership through application period.
- 2. All applicants are subject to a NON-REFUNDABLE \$25.00 Application Fee
- 3. Attend no less than four charter (general) meetings during six-month application period.
- 4. Attend Board of Directors meetings with sponsor at submission of application and at end of application period.
- 5. Applicants must fulfill all the obligations of this list within six (6) months of the application date, or the application will be removed.
- 6. Must work the Annual Field Day (or club event) if it falls during the application period.
- 7. Help at the Spring Clean-up if it falls during the application period.
- 8. Pay associate member prices for shooting.
- 9. Must work the required days during the Winter and Spring Trap/Skeet league if it falls during the application period. Must work twenty-five (25) ours on a work committee in addition to league obligation.
- 10. Obey ALL rules and regulations of the WWSC Shooting Ranges.
- 11. No guests on rifle and pistol ranges.

We have about 50 charters right now, but we need more people to be able to run events smoothly. If you are interested, please see a Charter member.

(Most of the people working are charter members.)

For the year you need 50 hours, which is about 1 shift a month. Most of the volunteers are working 3 or 4 shifts just to keep the range and shotgun desk open.

**MI License to Purchase (RI-010a) is needed prior to visiting the FFL for transfer.


NIC's check Forms can be obtained from your local police department where you live. ** Buyer is responsible for FFL transfer fees
