Club opens at 5pm. Dinner will be available.

Pick your partner 20 bird protection start 5:30pm. \$6/ shooter entry. Wobble and regular fields used.

50 Bird Program. \$20 entry. 1 round wobble trap from drawn yardage 16-21 yards. 1 round regular trap from drawn yardage 22-27 yards.

Program sign-up deadline 7pm. Partners drawn and auction at 7:30pm. Places paid determined before auction. Yardage drawn after the auction.

Squad 1 immediately to trap 2 for regular trap following auction. Finish round 1, squad 1 to trap 1 for wobble. Squad 2 to trap 1 upon squad 1's completion of regular. And so, on until all squads complete both rounds.

Shoot-off's will be 1 bird per partner per post from the 27 yard wobble trap for total of 10 birds.

Note: Club rules applied. Eye/ear pro required. Shot size 7.5 or smaller. Green targets may be used to combat evening lighting complications.

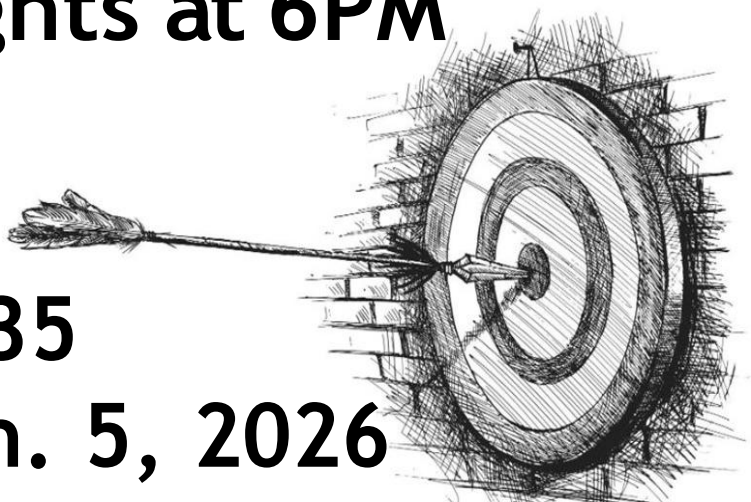
