As with any other shooting activity at the club, you must first sign and pay your shooting fee to the range monitor at the airgun / archery range before setting up your equipment to shoot. A range monitor must be present at the airgun / archery bag target range for members and non-members to shoot (this includes charter members). This is a new activity we are offering at the club, and it is imperative that we follow proper safety with equipment type, pellet caliber, range safety and course of fire when on this range. The range monitor or airgun committee member on duty will inspect shooters equipment and pellets prior to any shooting. *Please note that this is a dual use range and archers may be present during practice times, so please be respectful and mindful when an archer or air gunner needs to go down range to change out a target or retrieve arrows. We will use a safety flag system to indicate when the range is hot or cold and is safe to shoot or go down range. During league shooting times, we will have full use of the range (no archers).

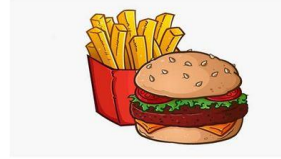
